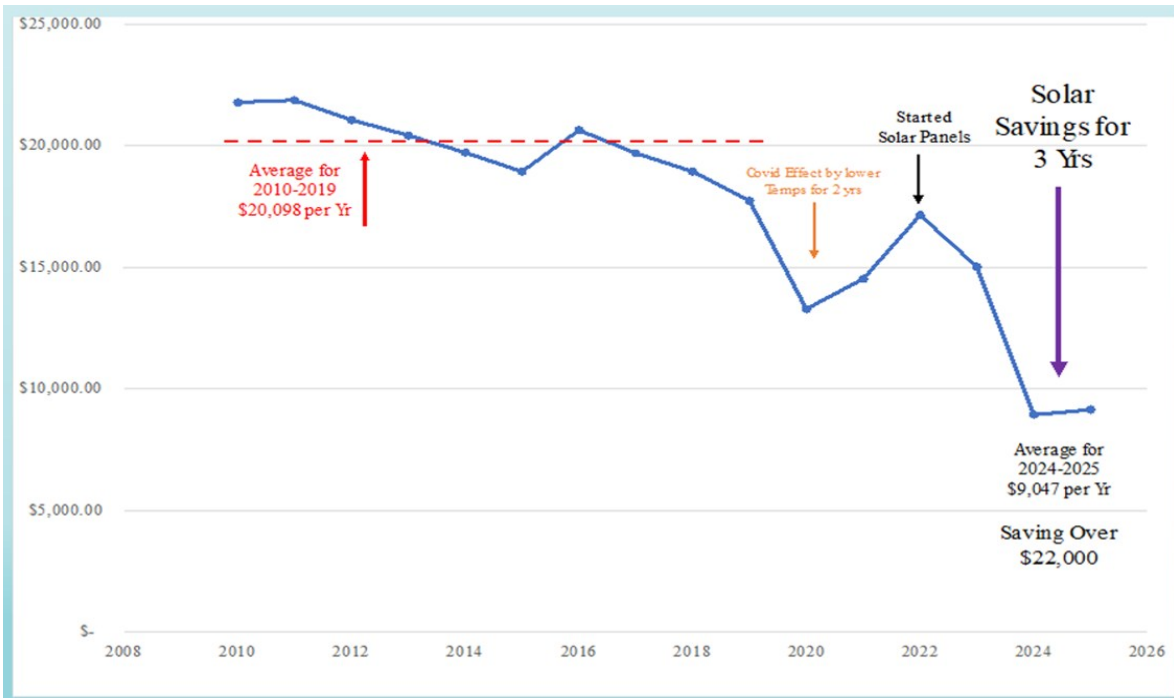

EFFECT OF SOLAR PANELS ON ECUMC ELECTRIC BILLS

We rejoice during Earth Week that our church protects God's creation through the 118 solar panels on the roof for the past three years. Our panels can generate 50 kilowatts of electricity and have produced 216 megawatt hours of electricity so far - enough to power 7,600 homes for a day or 21 homes for a year.

The dip at the end of this electricity costs chart shows that we have saved \$22,000 in electricity costs through solar energy, with more to be saved in the future. It has also kept 215 tons of harmful carbon dioxide out of our atmosphere, the equivalent of planting 43,000 trees.

Much of the cost of our solar installation has been paid for, but about \$14,500 is still owed, which is our church's only debt. If you would like to contribute to paying for this installation please make a contribution through an envelope in the offering plate or to the church office marked for the solar energy fund.
